

Unique Features: Tour Edge continues to surprise people with their technologically advanced clubs. The company's CB2 Hybrid features a chemically bonded titanium cupped face and hyper steel body. This gives the CB2 Hybrid explosive distance, great feel, and a sweet sound, not to mention a great deal of control and forgiveness. Anyone with an urge to perform club carpentry can mix and match weight screws in the back of the club, allowing them to change the center of gravity to their liking.

Tester Comments: Long does not describe how far I hit these ... Lots of power and really launches the ball ...

Unique Features: The QL has a fixed 15-gram tungsten sole weight creating a lower CG and a higher moment of inertia (the club's ability to resist twisting). The QL's thin Hyper-Steel walls allow more weight to be placed in the sole. The result is a 120-gram sole that lowers and deepens the CG position. A super-thin Hyper-Steel face makes the QL one of the hottest clubs you'll ever hit.

Tester Comments: Iron-like appearance gave me confidence, these are easy to hit ... Great trajectory and landed soft on the greens ... Once I got used to the look, I really hit these great.
