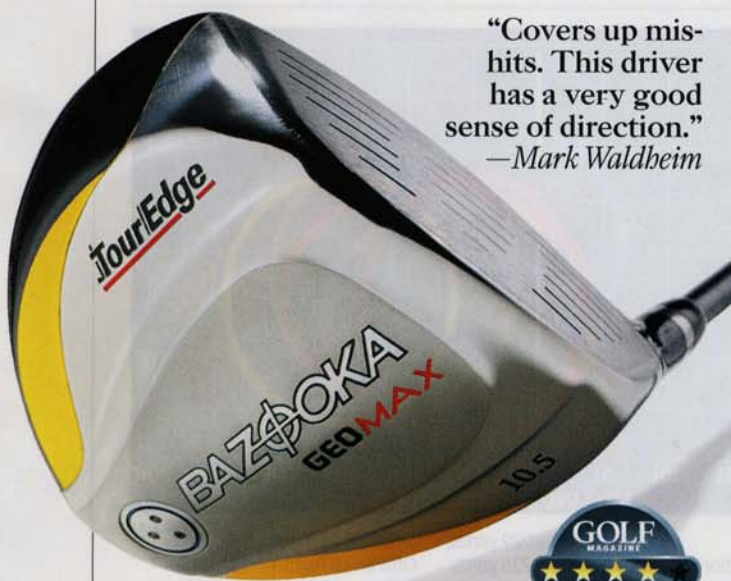

## Tour Edge Bazooka GeoMax

**WE TESTED:** 9°, 10.5°, 12°, 14°, 16° in Grafalloy GeoMax graphite shaft

**SHAFT LENGTH:** 45"

**COMPANY LINE:** "It features to-the-limit dimensions, for extreme forgiveness even on off-center hits, through a revolutionary geometric design. A 20-gram tungsten sole weight places the CG lower and deeper for a higher launch and unprecedented control."

### OUR TEST PANEL SAYS:

**PROS:** This baby keeps it in play, close to the centerline; easy to swing but hits hard; highest spin rate and overall ball flight in the test, you'll have no trouble sending tee shots high in the air; just enough feedback to let you know when you miss it; midnight blue metallic finish is a hit with testers.

**CONS:** High trajectory can cause slight distance lapse due to limited roll; clubhead is too light to feel all the way through the swing; even the stiff-flex shaft can be a little soft.
